# Florida Anthropological Society Student Paper Award Criteria

Student papers will be judged on both written and oral merits. A three-person committee will judge the papers using the following criteria.

#### I-Written Presentation

- A. Organization of Paper Must be clearly written in a coherent, logical, and organized format
- B. Development of Ideas/Thoroughness of Research Must demonstrate substantive knowledge of topic
- C. Significance of Research/Contribution to the Field

#### **II – Oral Presentation**

- A. Organization of Presentation
  Must present ideas in an organized and coherent format
- B. Communication Skills

  Must articulate and expresses ideas clearly and intelligibly
- C. Appropriate and effective use of technology, if appropriate.
